DNA BLOOD DRAW

The CSPCA DNA Committee will be holding a blood draw for samples to be banked at the University of Missouri Animal Genetics Laboratory DNA Bank. We will also be offering \$80.00 thyroid panels for CHIC testing. Dr. Rebecca Pentecost will be offering Patella exams for CHIC for \$15.00 - pending the judging schedule.
